Background On 1st March, 2019, Tanzania enforced a law that sought to reduce the axle load and weight of trucks by 3 to 4 tonnes. This has a financial implication on the foreign trucks as they would have to be resized. This issue arose because of Tanzania's need to comply to the East African Community (EAC) transport regulations, which were/are different from that of SADC that Zambia and other SADC countries follow. In this regard, the two countries expressed interest to bilaterally agree on how Zambian trucks, which are more than 17 metres, would enter Tanzania without being classified as "Abnormal Loads".
